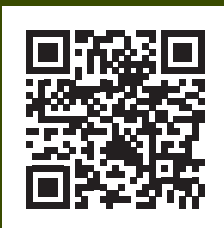

High School Graduation!



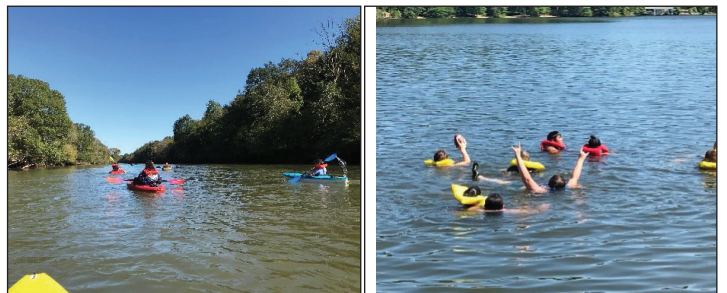
Logan Gibson
